## CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Morning Tea: 8.30am

Trial Ends: 8.50am

Play: As per Schedule.

1. To be played under the Laws of the Sport of Bowls and Women's Bowls NSW Conditions of Play.
2. The event will be played on a knockout principle. 25 shots up. Shots scored over 25 will not be counted. 4 bowls per player.
3. To be eligible an entrant must remain a member of the Club from which her entry was received. Please refer to Clubs Closing Policy for an exemption to this requirement.
4. Two trial ends before each game.
5. Dead Ends do not count and are to be replayed.
6. Players may only visit the head after their 3<sup>rd</sup> bowl or seek permission of the marker.
7. Uniform – only Women's Bowls NSW registered Club uniform may be worn.
8. Losers of A.M. games **must** be available to act as a marker in the next round or a fine determined by the Women's Bowls NSW Inc. will be imposed.
9. Fees are payable to the venue Club by all A.M. players. \$20 per player per day. For those playing in the PM, if you would like to be included in the lunch numbers, you will need to contact the venue directly and required to pay \$20. For PM players who do not wish to be included in lunch you will be required to pay \$8 green fees to the Club.
10. Markers lunches are being paid by Women's Bowls NSW.
11. **Players are asked to bring Magnetic Club Name Strip to be used during games.**
12. An open draw of Club Major Singles winners for the current bowling season, will be conducted by the Women's Bowls NSW Inc. Match Committee. Women's Bowls NSW will allocate rinks
13. All Women's Bowls NSW State Championships are now covered under our Smoke Free Greens Policy and smoking is not permitted behind the rinks of play, and only in designated areas.
14. Winner of this event is eligible to enter the Australian Singles Champion of Champions to be held 23<sup>rd</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> March 2021, at their own expense.
