## CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. The event will be conducted in sectional play. Post Sectional Play will be a knockout. **18 ends.** Four bowls each player and played alternately and in the following order – Lead 2x, Skip 2x, Lead 2x, Skip 2 bowls.
2. Entries are restricted to two members from any WBNSW affiliated Club, such members, at the time of entry to be the Club Pairs Champions for the current bowling season (January – December). Players must be dressed in the same registered club uniform
3. The entrant's full names must be stated on the Entry Form.
4. The Club Pairs event is to be played as an Open Draw, with no seeding of players and is regarded as an Association Event. The Club Pairs Championship event must be completed by the date specified.
5. Should a member of the Club Pairs Championship team resign from the Club prior to the commencement of the State event, the team shall be ineligible to compete.
6. No substitute is allowed for this event. If the original players who won the Club pairs cannot play after entry, then the team must forfeit.
7. For the State Playoff – THREE sessions a day MAY be scheduled.
8. Dead ends do not count and must be replayed.
9. If the game ends in a draw, an extra end will be played to achieve a result.
10. Delaying Play – If the umpire, either by their own observation or on appeal from one of the skips, decides that a player is deliberately delaying the delivery of the player's bowl: on first occasion the umpire will warn the player. If the player commits the same offence a second time the end will be regarded as completed and the opponents of the offender will score as many shots as there are bowls in use by such opponents. If the player offends a third time the game will be forfeited to the opponents.
11. For all State event play-offs, entrants are asked to bring a magnetic strip with Club name for the scoreboard.
12. Lunch will be provided for all A.M. players each day and must be paid for by competitors. \$20.00 per person. This fee includes cost of morning tea, lunch & Green Fees. Players with a morning bye will be charged \$8.00 per person green fees for their game.
13. All State Playoffs are now covered by the Smoke Free Greens Policy and smoking will only be permitted in designated areas at each Venue.
