

# **AUSTRALIAN INDOOR SINGLES QUALIFYING EVENT**

**WARILLA & EAST CESSNOCK BOWLING CLUBS**  
**Saturday 13<sup>th</sup>, Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> and Monday 15<sup>th</sup> February 2021**



## **CONDITIONS OF PLAY**

To be played under the Laws of the Sport of Bowls Crystal Mark 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition Version 3.1

1. Two sets of nine ends. Sectional play first two days then knockout.  
**A v B, C marks; C v loser A&B, winner marks; C v winner A&B, loser A&B marks.** Where there are four (4) in a section, markers will be provided - A v B, C v D; then, A v C, B v D; then, A v D, B v C.
2. Two trial ends per game.
3. In the event of a tie after two sets, a three-end tie break will be played, winner will be the player who has the most shots up after the completion of the tie break.
4. Players can approach the head after the third bowl, or after request to, and permission of the marker.
5. Club uniform – as approved by Women's Bowls NSW.
6. Play according to time schedule.
7. Trial ends 15 minutes before commencement of play.
8. All players should be at venue 30-minutes before their scheduled start time and check in with State Match Committee.
9. Any player arriving at the venue more than 15-minutes after the official starting time of their game shall forfeit the game.
10. Lunch is at player's own expense.
11. **Losers must make themselves available to mark in knock-out play. Any player not fulfilling this duty could be fined and denied entry in 2022.**
12. No dead ends, jack re-spotted on the 'T'. (Law 56.5.3)
13. 18 placegetters, in accordance with the number of entries, **from Warilla and East Cessnock**, qualify for the Australian Indoor Championships at Tweed Heads, 16<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> August 2021, at their own expense. If you do not intend to continue to the Australian Indoor Championships notify Women's Bowls NSW and BA.
14. In the event of any forfeits, players may be placed in other sections in a later timeslot and advised asap.
15. More detailed information regarding sets play will be displayed at Warilla and East Cessnock and can be found in the Laws of the Sport of Bowls, Law 56 – Sets Play (page 86).
16. **During knockout rounds, there will be no further play in a set if, at any point, it becomes impossible for one player to draw or win the set, given the number of ends left.**
17. A post sectional knock-out draw will be on display at Warilla and East Cessnock bowling clubs.
18. All bowls used during the event must carry a registered World Bowls stamp of either the current year or of a future year.
19. Action may be taken against a player delaying play, either after umpire's observation or opponent's appeal (See BA Conditions of Play for Australian Indoor available on BA website).
20. The Controlling Body reserves the right to alter the format, times of play and greens to suit unforeseen circumstances, giving as much notice as practical, to achieve a result.

NSW Match Committee will allocate rinks of play. Players wishing to forfeit 7 days or less than the scheduled commencement of play **MUST** notify the Venue Match Committee Co-Ordinator.
