

	SUMMER LEAGUE 2020/2021 – CONDITIONS OF PLAY
Objective	To provide an “out of hours” competition that all affiliated members of WBNSW can participate in when traditional ladies days are not suitable. Juniors and the employed are encouraged to enter.
Play Day Restrictions	Any day of the week but must be commenced after 4pm during the week, by mutual agreement of all players involved, and anytime on week ends. No player can be made to play before 6pm.
Commencement	No earlier than October with post sectional play to be finalised by 5 February 2021. State finals will be contested on 27/28 February 2021.
Control	Districts shall conduct the event on behalf of WBNSW Match Committee. District will receive entries and conduct sectional random draws as required. Play is on a home and away basis. There is no minimum number per section and no limit on the number of sections. Winning Clubs are to report results to District Match on the first business day after each round.
Grading Restrictions	Teams are restricted to 1 player who has played grade 1 or grade 2 pennants in the previous 2 years. Players positions may be changed after each round.
Team Entries	Teams are self selected and can be composite teams as long as each player belongs to the same District. Teams must nominate a home club. Teams to nominate their play day for home games on their entry form. There is no restriction on the number of entries from each club. Teams must provide a team name on their entry form.
Controlling Body/ Umpire	The home club shall provide the Controlling Body and an Umpire.
Format	2 bowl triples over 15 ends. No dead ends the jack is to be re-spotted on the “T”. 1 trial end before each game. Leads and seconds cannot visit the head until after they have played their second bowl.
Scoring	Win =2 points, Draw = 1 point, Forfeit =2 points plus the average winning margin, of that section. No points awarded for a loss.
Determining the Winner	In the event of a points draw in any section at the conclusion of sectional play, the team with the highest margins will be the winner, if still a draw the team then with the highest number of ends won.
Dress	BA approved attire. Club uniform or teams may have a BA approved team shirt. Players are not required to be dressed in the same uniform
Substitutes	One substitute is permitted per match but 2 of the original team members must contest each round. If 2 original members are not available a replacement player may be introduced, once only.
Finals Location /Dates	Finals will be held at Blacktown Workers Club on 27 and 28 February 2021. Players are responsible for their own accommodation and travel expenses. \$20 per player, per day is required for meals and green fees. Depending on the number of entries, play may need to commence on Friday 26 February 2021.
Finals	Entry for State finals is to be forwarded to WBNSW no later than 5 February 2021 by the District Secretary, together with the State entry fee of and a copy of the fully completed sectional and post sectional draws. The full names and ID numbers of all players are to be included where required on the entry form as well as on the draw sheets. Winning team is responsible for ensuring their entry is submitted. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
Schedule of Play at State Final	The number of winning district entries received will determine the number of matches to be contested at state playoffs. A random sectional draw will be conducted by WBNSW Match committee. Sectional winners will be drawn for a post sectional knockout. Some matches may be required to be played in the evenings.
Conditions of Play	Played under the Laws of the Sport except for specific conditions of play above and eligibility criteria. Women’s Bowls NSW policies apply.
Trophies	State winners and runners-up will be receiving recognition.
